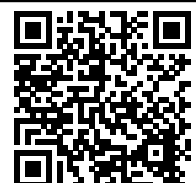

The solid mahogany fall opens to reveal a black leather writing surface with a fitted interior which has various pigeon holes and 4 small drawers each with 2 brass pulls. This quality piece of Georgian period furniture has a wonderful original colour and patina and stands on it's original offset shaped bracket feet. Has good oak linings and panelled back throughout and working locks and key. C1790.
