Mid C18th George II period mahogany chest of drawers of exceptional colour and originality. Fine example of a mid Georgian period chest of 4 long drawers having a wonderful rich colour and patina. Raised on original exaggerated ogee section shaped bracket feet, with canted and reeded corners. The twin plank construction solid mahogany top of well-figured timber with a glowing gently faded patination. The oak-lined graduated and 'cock-beaded' 4 long drawers all fitted with the original brass 'swan-neck' handles and cast brass key escutcheons. Original pine backboards. A well-proportioned chest of neat scale, width and attractive low height in excellent original condition. Minor historic repairs and marks commensurate with age, use and purpose.
