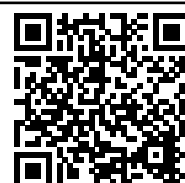

This one measures eight inches in diameter, perfect for a small serving tray, this size, I also find most useful for collecting incoming or outgoing mail and cut a dash desk-top for business cards. This example has a pierced or reticulated gallery, followed by an engraved Greek Key design and a highly decorative central cartouche, which is vacant and could be engraved if desired. There is a hallmark EPNS for Electro-plated Nickel Silver together with the makers mark MH & Co for Martin Hall and Company. Martin Hall & Co was one of the best known British manufacturers and participated in many international exhibitions including the Crystal Palace Great Exhibition in 1851.
