A good quality antique late Victorian bedroom chair in beautifully figured rosewood by the cabinet makers Marsh Jones and Cribb. With a top rail with carved swag decoration and curved rail back it stands on tapering square legs terminating in original brass casters. The seat is upholstered in a dark green coloured velvet style fabric. With paper label underneath reading: "Marsh, Jones & Cribb (Late Kendal & Co)" with the workers name written in pencil. This is quite a low chair so would make an ideal dressing table chair or bedroom chair. Dating from circa 1895. Marsh, Jones & Cribb were a prestigious 19th Century cabinet makers, known for producing high quality furniture and their close association with leading designers of the Victorian era such as Charles Bevan, Bruce Talbert and W.R. Lethaby. Originally established as Marsh & Jones circa 1850 in Leeds, they later expanded to Cavendish Square London and becoming Marsh, Jones & Cribb in 1867.
