The writing surface is fitted with a sumptuous tan coloured leather, complete with gilt tooled decoration. The super-structure is supported by barley twist columns, has a mirrored back and a brass gallery to the top. The main body of the table has a series of 3 drawers and stands on stylish barley twist turned legs which are united by a matching cross stretcher. The feet terminate in their original brass castors. It is finished to the rear so could be free-standing within a room if desired.
