It is of cylindrical form and comprises of a separate shaving brush, a hollow cylindrical handle/cover and a circular lid. Each part is separately hallmarked. The handle with beautiful engine-turned decorations surrounding a crested circular reserve. Hallmarks: AB over JR for Abraham Brownnett & John Rose. Lion passant. London Assay Mark. Duty Mark.
