A superb example of a burr walnut knee hole desk in the early Georgian style. Dating to the late 19th century and of excellent construction in solid walnut with attractive, yet subtle, burr walnut veneers onto a solid oak carcass. Of gentle serpentine form with canted corners and with the top being cross-banded. There is an arrangement of one long central drawer flanked by two sets of 4, shorter, graduated drawers. All fitted with their original charming brass handles. To the knee hole there is a bow-fronted cupboard (lockable with key supplied) which opens to reveal a shelved interior. The whole desk stands on elegant shaped bracket feet. Recently professionally repolished to a very high standard, this desk is now offered for sale in excellent condition.
