The carving is of very fine quality, it has scrolls acanthus leaves and flowers, set in 4 arched scallop chamfered panels, the top is made from 2 planks of thick oak and the piece is set on large Georgian style bracket feet. This is a wonderful looking piece it is 18th Century in the main, it is heavy and in good sturdy condition commensurate with its age.
