## Description

Circa 1880-1910. A pair of late Victorian gilded bronze lamps that were most likely originally for use with candles and converted to lamps some time ago. They have been totally rewired using flex cable and fitted with an online switch, and the candle tubes have been replaced. They measure 30cm in total in height; 27.5cm up to the top of the candle tube, and the approximate diameter of the base is 19cm. The cherubs themselves are about 13cm in height. They are an exact pair - a Right and a Left. The gilding is worn in places, (see knees and some patches on the arms at the back) otherwise they are in good condition with no signs of repair or damage. They are very heavy and very well made. The price includes postage and packing within the UK mainland only, and for remote parts or delivery abroad, please contact us for a quote for delivery. Alternatively, they can be viewed by appointment with us in Surrey as we no longer sell through a retail outlet.
