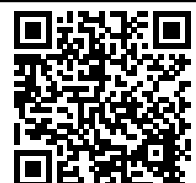

Kenworthy was on show at the Municipal Art Exhibition in Whitehaven. It was shown again in an exhibition for J.D. Kenworthy's 90th birthday in 1948. It is described as coming from the Masonic Hall, College Street.
