This is the traditional shape of a Dairy table, the 2" thick plank top has a pointed end and there is a gully around the edge which gets deeper as it reaches the drain hole and so allows the whey to be collected beneath. The table is in bare wood, it has never been painted or polished, it would look fantastic if it was polished this would really enhance the beautiful elm grain if you wished to use it as a kitchen dining table, but we have left it in original condition.
