The brass lock plate is engraved with the makers name with "Maison Alph Giroux Paris" The interior is in Mahogany and Brass, the interior stand is removable so it can sit separately when the liqueurs are being poured, Inside we have complete set of 4 decanters and 16 liqueur glasses, these are quite charming they are etched with delicate scenes of animals and woodlands.
