A Matched Clock & Thermometer Set By Auguste Breul of Paris, Dated 1841. Auguste Breul, clockmaker and bronze-worker active in Paris in the mid-19th century, in his workshop executed centerpieces, candelabra, clocks and many other bronze objects which would embellish the dining rooms and the sitting rooms of the best noble families in Europe. The beautifully inlaid figured coromandel wood cases, with floral and butterfly decoration to the fronts and brass stringing throughout. The inlays are in perfect condition, superbly executed and very detailed. The scrolled and carved pediments with finely cast and decorated brass bezels beneath. The fully restored fine quality spring driven 8 day silk suspension movement, count wheel striking the hours and half hour on a single bell, stamped for the maker to the back plate, Auguste Breul, Rue De Lancry 5, Paris. The silvered brass dial with decorated centre and trefoil blued steel hands. The finely engraved silvered brass thermometer with circular alcohol thermometer indicating the centigrade and Reaumur scale, signed Paris. Overall a very fine set in wonderful original condition, with fine patination and colour. All of o...
