Detachable wax pans sit neatly into the sconces and can be removed for ease of cleaning. The base beneath each candlestick is felted. A striking pair of candlesticks. Hallmarks and maker's marks: Hallmarked Birmingham 1902 with maker's marks for Synyer & Beddoes (Harry Synyer & Charles Joseph Beddoes). The marks on one of the candlesticks is very slightly rubbed but still clear enough to read! : Condition: These Candlesticks are in great antique condition.
