The knife handle is made from a particularly beautiful mother of pearl, wonderfully coloured and very tactile to hold, and is decorated with a small armorial of a Lion bearing a cross. The silver blade of the knife is beautifully engraved with pretty leaves and the collar is embossed with a leaf design. Clear hallmarks are visible on the blade for the Sheffield Assay Office with a date mark for 1881. The Lion Passant is also visible along with the maker's marks for Roberts & Belk. This is a particularly handsome, yet practical piece. Condition: This knife is in excellent antique condition. Hallmarks and maker's marks: Sheffield 1881 by Roberts & Belk.
