This attractive whatnot is in very good and original condition and retains its original "Cope's Patent" castors. It is unusual to find an entire piece of furniture made from Birds-eye maple, so called because of the appearance the figure resembles small bird's eyes. It occurs occasionally in *Acer saccharum* (Sugar Maple) trees and is said to be the result of poor growing conditions. 780mm high, 360mm wide and 360mm deep. Circa 1850.
