A Stunning Victorian silver mounted scent bottle. This outstanding example features a cylindrical ruby glass body surrounded by a hallmarked silver serpent and topped with a hinged silver lid. The lid is decorated with a cabochon garnet, replicated in the serpent's eyes. The lid opens to reveal a fully gilded interior and the original peg stopper. Serpent scent bottles are rare items, usually found in clear glass and a ruby example is most uncommon.
