Lovely inlaid work and black line stringing. The satinwood itself has a wonderful iridescence and is of the highest quality. A striking piece of fine Edwardian furniture having been sympathetically restored in excellent condition for the home. Width 122cm Depth 53cm Height 107.5cm Edwards & Roberts was founded in 1845, and had premises at 21 Wardour Street London. By 1892 they occupied more than a dozen buildings in Wardour Street, where they continued to trade until the end of the century. They became one of the leading London cabinet makers and retailers working in a variety of styles, both modern and revivalist. Their business also involved retailing, adapting and restoring the finest antique furniture and there are many examples of their earlier furniture with later embellishments bearing their stamp.
