This superb item is a silver bone holder for carving. It would traditionally have been used for lamb and its name in French is Manche a gigot d'agneau. It is of superior quality and was hallmarked for Paris 1882 -1901. The tapering handle is cast with acanthus leaves and the base terminal has a flower bud shaped grip, with spikes and a screw for tightening. To the front cartouche is a script monogram. A handsome and rare item with a practical use.
