A fine quality true Vienna regulator wall clock made by Johannes Lehrner in Kaschau, circa 1835. Johannes Lehrner in Kaschau (Upper Hungary): Master 1813, came from Griserdorf in Austria, manufactured between 1820 and 1840 precision clocks with long gear duration and glass-encapsulated works and special designs. The beautifully made six light, roof top design, flame mahogany case with contrasting boxwood stringing throughout and flame mahogany backboard. The fully restored 8 day weight driven movement of the finest quality, with high quality gear work, deadbeat escapement and slide beat adjustment. The polished steel rod pendulum with a brass backed knife edged polished brass bob, ornate spoked pulley, polished cylindrical brass weight and silvered brass beat plate to the backboard. The one piece 7 inch diameter white porcelain dial, signed to the centre Lehrner Kaschau, with Roman numerals chapter ring, enclosed within a fine quality cast brass engine turned bezel with detailed decoration. Finely fretted blued steel hands, of beetle and poker design. A beautifully made clock of elegant and restrained proportions typical of the Dachluhr / early Biedermeier period, i...
