A mahogany Late Victorian Period antique pedestal desk by Hindley & Sons of London. Having a rectangular solid mahogany top with an inset rouge leather writing surface with blind and gilt tooled detail and a moulded edge. With an arrangement of nine rectangular drawers each with solid mahogany fronts, oak and cedar linings, an aesthetic style solid brass handle and retaining the original locks and working key. The pedestals are flanked by fluted columns with solid mahogany panelled ends and back. The whole supported on a mahogany plinth with concealed castors.
