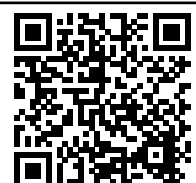

The underside of the lid marked EPNS for Electro-Plated Nickel Silver, there isn't a makers mark but these items were invariably made by John Grinsell or Daniel and Arter. Dating to around 1890, it remains in excellent condition measuring 5 1/2" handle to handle x 5 1/4" x 3" tall to lid finial.
