It sits on a neat circular spreading foot and has a nice loop handle to one side and a lovely deep lemon coloured gilt interior. In the centre of the mug is a circular empty cartouch. Very clear hallmarks are visible on the base for the London Assay Office with a date mark for 1884 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver.
