Description

A very fine solid silver, Victorian, Pepperette / Dredger. The perfectly shaped dome top pulls off the cylindrical base, which is a nice simple design with no engravings or embossing. It has a lovely large loop handle to one side. The side of the body of the Pepperette shows very clear hallmarks for The Birmingham Assay Office with a date mark of 1899, as well as the Lion Passant for sterling silver. The maker's marks are for 'S.B'. Condition: This item is in great antique condition. There are two very tiny dings, one around the rim at the top, and one at near to the bottom of the Dredger (see image 5), commensurate with the age of the item that we mention for accuracy only. Hallmarks and maker's marks: Birmingham 1899 by S.B. Measurements: Height 5.1 cm approx. Width including handle: 4.6 cm approx. Width excluding handle: 2.6 cm approx. Weight: 15.17 grams approx.
