Description

A handsome large Victorian brass and steel padlock by the famous Chubb & Son of London. In 1823, the Chubb company was awarded a special license to supply King George IV and the royal household. They later became the sole supplier of locks to the General Post Office and a supplier to Her Majesty's Prison Service. In 1827, Chubb opened its first London premises at 57 St Paul's Churchyard. They remained at this location until 1877 before moving to 128 Queen Victoria Street, London. The lock is fully marked to the front with the address dating this one to around 1850, early Victorian in era.
