Fine quality late C19th satinwood side table in the late Georgian period style . An elegant table of free-standing form , raised upon square tapering legs . The quarter-veneered 'book-matched' top of highly-figured satinwood , with 'barber's pole' chequer stringing and a hare-wood cross-banded edge . The frieze fitted with a single cedar-lined drawer ,the front with brass ring handles with circular back-plates . The legs joined by a cross stretcher with a central cross-banded satinwood veneered oval disc patera with conforming chequer stringing, the ends of the legs with harewood tips . A high-quality table throughout ,conceived in the late C18th Georgian period style . Excellent colour , patina and condition, with no losses, damage or repairs . H 28" W 20" D 15" England c. 1900
