Lunar moon phases to the arch with a sailing frigate. Date and seconds indicators. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. William Preece of Bristol was born in Hereford in 1783 and moved to Bristol and worked at Redcliffe Hill from 1804-1809. He lived in Twinnell Road until around 1851.
