Description

A quite wonderful antique solid of sterling silver hip or liquor flask dating to the nineteenth century complete with it's removable drinking cup or beaker. I particularly like this example with the regal engraved crown on both the flask and the cup which I believe to be a Baronet's crown. There is also a great clear hallmark to both pieces for London 1885 together with the makers mark GH, I think for George Heath. The hinged lid is a bayonet style, requiring a quarter turn and lift action, revealing the original cork in the inside of the cap to avoid evaporation of the precious contents.
