Regency period mahogany twin-pedestal dining table; the tops with rounded corners and reeded edges, hinged and mounted on elegant pedestals with cannon-barrel shafts and four splayed legs with brass box-casters; the two loose leaves and their bearers are replacements fitted about 30 years ago. With its adjustable leaves, table length can be 59", 83" or, fully extended, 107". The table has provenance from Air Marshal Sir Brian Reynolds (1902 - 65) who had a distinguished wartime career.
