Description

A very, very fine example of an ebonised mantel clock of small proportions. The 8 day Winterhalder & Hoffman movement strikes the quarters on a nest of 8 bells and the hours on a gong. It has a Grande Sonnerie repeat pull. The movement has just been completely overhauled by our BHI registered staff. The clock retains it's original, huge winding key (always a sign that a clock has come from a caring home). An arched brass dial with gilt spandrels, rise and fall, and STRIKE/SILENT subsidiary dials. A silvered chapter ring with black engraved Roman numerals and interspaced fluer-de lis markings and matted centre. Gilt cariatids to the canted corners, gilt, splayed bracket feet and additional gilt adornments to the lower half. The bevelled glass opening door has a complete gilt rope-work effect surround. The polished ebonised case is in superb original condition and has arched gilt soundfrets to the sides. Shown dimensions include all finials. An absolutely stunning clock. All cards accepted.
