The brass has been meticulously polished and with various marks including S-3 / 44912 and the military crows foot. They are fitted with shades to minimise glare in bright sunshine. The leather case is in great polished antique condition. Excellent condition, the binoculars measuring 5" x 2 3/8" x 5 1/2" expanding to 7" while sunshades are in operation.
