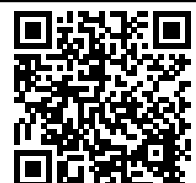

Very often marks on mote spoons are unclear, so it is wonderful to be able to identify the maker. The bowl pierced with scrolls and cross lets. Bottom marked. Hallmarks: MD surmounted by a crown for Marmaduke Daintrey, this is his early hallmark, dating the spoon to circa 1730. Dimensions: 13cm Condition: Very good bowl with no loss to pierced decorations.
