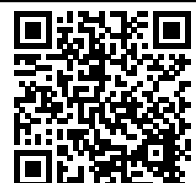
A fine quality Regency period mahogany wine-cooler of sarcophagus form; the hinged lid having a figured panel with a beaded moulded edge raised on concave sides with beaded moulded base. The waisted body has flared veneered panel within astragal moulded frames, the corners of rope-twist ending in fine brass claw-feet.
