Fine quality rare late C19th Qing Dynasty Chinese hardwood Scholar's table or stand in hongmu. For use on a larger scholar's as a small table for placements of scholar's items and precious objects, such as an ink-stone, brush pot, wrist-rest, items of jade etc.. The objects were in a sense the luxury items of their time, but rather than wealth they represented the physical embodiment of the scholars intellectual curiosity and aesthetic taste. The rectangular low stand or table with a 'floating' panel top and with inset panelled ends. The open-work frieze with ruyi motif carvings (symbolic of good fortune) and 'endless knot' style frets to the corners. Of free-standing form, raised upon square legs with a shaped foot. In excellent original condition, has been cleaned and waxed in our workshops. H 7" W 18" D 12" China c.1880
