Description

An early 17th Century gateleg table of fine colour and patination. This is quite an unusual table as the rails and finely turned baluster legs that make up the base is entirely constructed of fruit wood and the top is made from figurative ash. The drawer still has its original drop handles, escutcheon, lock and linings and there is a crack in the drawer pan but this does not affect its strength. There are some areas with old worm damage but nothing significant. Its a fabulous dining table and works well with the Thames valley yew wood chairs I have up for sale separately.
