His wife stood to his side, and his son crouched behind him. All upon a shared base. Signed to base. Height - 5 cm, 2". Width - 3.5 cm, 1 3/8". Depth - 2.6 cm, 1". Condition - Some typical age cracks, commensurate with age. Otherwise excellent condition. No repairs.
