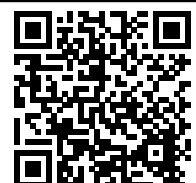
Description

A large and impressive antique Chippendale revival fretwork framed wall mirror or overmantle in George 11 style and dating from the late 19th century. The later oblong plate in a scroll and leaf-carved frame with a shell-carved crest and apron, (re-painted). With label to back: "T.R. Smith Carver & Gilder.... Restorer. Bottle Lane, Nottingham. Thomas Richard Smith (1851-1933), was a craver, gilder and restorer working from premises at 14-16 Bottle Lane, Nottingham from the late 19th Century to the Early 20th Century. Construction/Wood: Gilt gesso and Pine. It has been repainted at some point. Condition Report: Mirror plate is a replacement. Marks and scuffs commensurate with age. It has been repainted in gold paint at some point. Dimensions: Frame Width: 92cm Frame Height: 79cm Depth: 4cm Mirror Plate: 75cm x 49cm
