The reverse side of the spoon bears the very clear hallmarks for the London Assay Office with a date mark for 1809 and the Lion Passant indicating sterling silver, with maker's marks for the silversmiths Richard Turner and John Shea. A charming caddy spoon in great antique condition. Hallmarks and maker's marks: London 1809 by Richard Turner & John Shea. Measurements: Length of spoon: 9.1 cm approx. Width of bowl: 3 cm approx.
