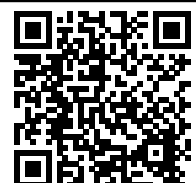
Description

The chest with 3 drawers under the top, and a further 3 graduated drawers below. Each drawer with a walnut cross banding around the edges, bordered by herringbone inlay. A banding runs up the middle of the drawer to form a panel of walnut to each side. This is a very decorative feature. The top of boarded chestnut with herringbone inlay and a walnut cross banding to the edge. This chest may have originally been the top section of a chest on chest.
