A fine quality Austrian mahogany and boxwood inlaid 'Dachluhr' regulator wall clock of one month duration. The elegant flame mahogany case having an architectural pediment with inlaid banding, six light glazed front door and sides, below a concave sided base, in excellent condition with fine patination and colour. The silvered dial with Roman numerals surrounded by a guilloché ormolu bezel, the recessed centre signed Peter Peuker in Wien, with ormolu rim to match the outer bezel. Finely fretted blued steel hands of beetle and poker design. The fully restored 30 day weight driven movement of the highest quality, with deadbeat escapement and maintaining power. Brass bob pendulum with polished steel rod, cylindrical brass weight and spoked pulley. Original brass winding key. A very elegant clock of beautiful proportions in fine condition. This type of Viennese regulator wall clock were entirely hand made by a time served master clockmaker and were only made for the most discerning customers and took many months to complete individually. All of our clocks have been sympathetically restored and have been expertly vetted for originality and good working order....
