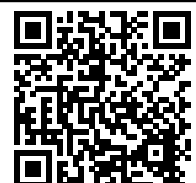
A delightful and interesting item of Victorian silver. This rare piece is a vesta with a combined sovereign holder. This lovely example has stylish plain body with engraved stylized initials to the reverse. The front is charmingly engraved with the words, 'Matches' and 'Gold' to the corresponding compartments. The vesta is lid hinged and fully gilded to the interior. The sovereign holder has a push button sprung lid and retains some original gilding to the inside.
