The 14" dia., white painted dial has black Roman numerals, subsidiary seconds dial and superbly cut hands. It has a key-lockable wooden turned bezel. The hood slides off for access to the movement. The flame mahogany case retains it's original Frech-polished finish and is immaculate throughout. The fully glazed, key-lockable door allows the heavy, regulator pendulum to be seen working. The superb brass weights are in perfect condition as is the pendulum. The base of the case terminates in a quarter round finish that compliments the very high quality of this superb clock.
