The ivory-white marble mausoleum at Agra was commissioned by the Emperor to house the tomb of Mumtaz Mahal. Shown seated upon a fine carpet with Jali-work panels and vases behind. The octagonal edge with fine quality gilding. The borders with trailing flower designs. The painting throughout of exquisite quality and craftsmanship.
