An arched brass dial with herringbone chased dial edging and cast spandrels. A date aperture, seconds and strike/silent lever. An 8-day duration mechanism with 5 pillars striking the hours on a bell. Brass cased weights. John Rasher of London is recorded in Baillies' 'Watch and 'Clockmakers of The World' book as working in from 1695-1721. Joseph is likely to be a family member.
