The Card Case opens by pressing a catch on the side to reveal a beautiful Silky Pink lining with two pockets to hold your business or credit cards and the case is of a size that can still be used today with modern business / credit cards. The catch closes tightly, the hinge is in good condition and there are very few signs of use or wear despite this being almost 160 years old. 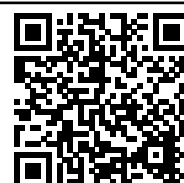
