This amusing and delightful bronze is signed to the base and retains its original warm colour and patina. 18ins (45.5cms) high. ***Vincent-Desire Faure de Brousse, a French sculptor, was a student of Hugo Salmson in Paris. He presented some of his work at the Paris Salon 1876-1883 and died in 1908.
