Description

Late C18th George III period mahogany 'bachelor's' chest of drawers. Good small-scale mahogany chest of four long drawers fitted with a brushing slide. The gently graduated 'cock-beaded' four drawers all fitted with original brass 'swan-neck' handles , the pull-out slide with polished interior and fitted with original brass 'axe-head' handles . The drawers all fitted with original brass escutcheons and retaining their locks , but key lacking. Raised on solid shaped bracket feet , the top having a simple 'thumb-moulded' edge . In good original condition , with a rich patina. The solid single-piece top having been professionally repolished in the traditional manner to remove historic water-marks . The drawers all with original oak linings . The reverse fitted with the original back-boards. A charming and useful small- scale late Georgian period chest of drawers in ready to use condition. Some minor marks and historic minor repairs, commensurate with age and use. H 33" W 30.5" D 18" England c. 1780
