The stretchers were called this, as it is said that it was so that the ladies crinoline dresses would fit underneath the chairs when they were sitting on the chair. The central splat arm and hoop to the back have the eyes of the yew, that sets yew apart from the standard ash and elm versions. Yew is always the most desirable timber on such a chair, as it gives a colour and patina other woods do not normally match.
