They look magnificent in the home or grand in an office setting. This version has the rare feature of a lift up lid. When opened it reveals a open storage area. At the time this chest was made many interesting events were making the news. Lord Palmerston had just increased his majority in a General Election. A train crash at Staplehurst had occurred, with 10 fatalities, Charles Dickens was one of the survivors. Edward Whymper led a party that made the first ascent of the Matterhorn Lewis Carrol's Alice's adventure in Wonderland was first published.
