A very rare, solid silver, Christening Mug. In baluster form, the mug is a simply plain polished silver with no embossing or engraving, however, the handle to one side is extremely unusual and represents a crescent moon with a 'man in the moon' face featured. One side of the mug bears the hallmarks for the Birmingham Assay Office with a date mark of 1929 and maker's marks for Horton & Allday (these marks are slightly rubbed, however, are still distinguishable). There is also a reg number on the moon handle: 735492. A superb and unusual mug in great antique condition. Birmingham 1929 by Horton & Allday. Measurements: Height: 6.3 cm approx. Width including handle: 7.4 cm approx. Diameter width excluding handle 6 cm approx. Weight: 49 grams approx.
